

Format and Guidelines for Poster Presentation

(National Level)

The 10th National and International Conference on Academic and Research Presentations, 2026

Preparation Instructions

Presenters are required to prepare their posters according to the specified format.

One research study must be presented on one poster page, consisting of the required sections outlined below.

Poster Size and Format

General Format

- Use **TH SarabunPSK** font, size **18–22**, or adjust as appropriate for readability and aesthetics.
- Prepare the poster in **A4 size** and save the file in **.pdf format**.
- Set page margins at **2.54 cm (1 inch)** on the top, bottom, left, and right.
- Place the **presenter's institutional logo** at the **top-left corner** of the poster.

Title Section

- The **research title** must use **font size 22 or larger**, or as appropriate.
- The **presenter's name** must also use **font size 22 or larger**, or as appropriate.
- Both the **research title** and the **presenter's name** must be **bold** and aligned at the **top center** of the poster.

Required Content Sections

1. **Abstract**
2. **Introduction**
3. **Research Methodology**
4. **Research Findings**

5. Discussion and Conclusion

6. Recommendations (if any)

7. References

Poster Submission

- Submit the poster file in **.pdf format** by **10 April 2026**.
